1 A memorial resolution for deceased members of the Senate of North Dakota.

2 **WHEREAS**, God has welcomed to their eternal home our former colleagues:

3 John D. Decker, who served in the 40th and 41st Legislative Assemblies, from District 5, died
4 February 26, 2009;

5 Donald W. Hanson, who served in the 45th through the 47th Legislative Assemblies, from
6 District 45, died May 13, 2009;

7 Geraldine "Jerry" Meyer, who served in the 48th through the 51st Legislative Assemblies,
8 from District 3, died July 22, 2010;

9 Walter A. Meyer, who served in the 49th through the 51st Legislative Assemblies, from
10 District 53, died October 6, 2010;

11 Theron L. Strinden, who served in the 38th and 39th Legislative Assemblies, from District 38,
12 and in the 41st through 46th Legislative Assemblies, from District 24, died March 3, 2011;

13 William J. Thoreson, who served in the 41st and 42nd Legislative Assemblies, from
14 District 12, died March 3, 2009;

15 Carrol Torgerson, who served in the 38th and 39th Legislative Assemblies, from District 16,
16 and in the 40th and 41st Legislative Assemblies, from District 23, died June 26, 2010;

17 Jerry Waldera, who served in the 48th through the 51st Legislative Assemblies, from
18 District 37, died November 26, 2009;

19 **WHEREAS**, we now pause to mourn the passing of our former Senate colleagues and to
20 honor their memories; and

21 **WHEREAS**, these legislators rendered outstanding service to the people of the state by
22 their contributions to public service;

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

25 of North Dakota, of the loyal and devoted service of our former colleagues; and

3 that the Secretary of State present enrolled copies of this resolution to the surviving families of
