- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-05-20.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to branding of certificate of title.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-05-20.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-05-20.3. Grounds for refusing certificate of title.**

7 The department shall not issue a certificate of title or transfer a certificate of title upon any8 of the following grounds:

- 9 1. When the application contains any false or fraudulent statements or when the
- 10 applicant has failed to furnish required information or reasonable additional information
- requested by the department or when the applicant is not entitled to the issuance of a
 certificate of title under this chapter.
- 13 2. When the vehicle is mechanically unfit or unsafe to be operated or moved upon thehighways.
- 15 3. When an out-of-state title presented for transfer is branded scrap, parts-only, junk,
- unrepairable, nonrebuildable, certificate of destruction, dismantler, or some similar
 notation indicating the vehicle cannot be retitled and registered for use on public

18 <u>roadways.</u>

- 4. When the department has reason to believe the vehicle is a stolen or embezzled
 vehicle or the granting of title would constitute a fraud against the rightful owner or
 other person having valid lien upon the vehicle.
- 4.5. When the certificate of title is suspended or revoked for any reason as provided in the
 motor vehicle laws of this state.
- 24 <u>5.6.</u> When the required fee has not been paid.

- 1 <u>6.7.</u> When any sales tax or motor vehicle excise tax, properly due, has not been paid.
- 2 <u>7.8.</u> For failure to provide security for payment of basic no-fault benefits and the liabilities
- 3 covered under motor vehicle liability insurance on a motor vehicle as required by4 chapter 26.1-41.
