ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2085

(At the request of the Agriculture Commissioner)

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact subsection 3 to section 4.1-47-05 and subdivision c to  
2 subsection 1 of section 4.1-47-31 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the process by  
3 which the noxious weed list is amended and the penalty for selling noxious weeds; to amend  
4 and reenact section 4.1-47-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the control and  
5 sale of noxious weeds; to provide a penalty; and to allow the agriculture commissioner to use  
6 environment and rangeland protection funds for invasive species control.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

8 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4.1-47-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
9 amended and reenacted as follows:

10 **4.1-47-02. Control of noxious weeds –Responsibility.**

- 11 1. Each person shall do all things necessary and proper to control the spread of noxious
- 12 weeds.
- 13 2. No person may distribute, sell, or offer for sale within this state a noxious weed.

14 **SECTION 2.** Subsection 3 to section 4.1-47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
15 created and enacted as follows:

- 16 3. In adding or removing weeds from the noxious weed list the commissioner is not
- 17 required to comply with rulemaking requirements in chapter 28-32.

18 **SECTION 3.** Subdivision c to subsection 1 of section 4.1-47-31 of the North Dakota Century  
19 Code is created and enacted as follows:

- 20 c. A person who violates subsection 2 of section 4.1-47-02 is subject to a civil
- 21 penalty not to exceed one hundred dollars for each violation.

22 **SECTION 4. ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND - INVASIVE**

23 **SPECIES CONTROL.** The agriculture commissioner may use up to \$50,000 of the amount  
24 available to the commissioner from legislative appropriation for the biennium beginning July 1,

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- 1 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, from environment and rangeland protection funds for the
- 2 purpose of controlling invasive species as provided by section 4.1-47-33.
