- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-10-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to disobedience of a judicial order; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-10-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **12.1-10-05. Disobedience of judicial order.**

- A personAn individual is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if the personindividual
 disobeys or resists a lawful temporary restraining order or preliminary or final
 injunction or other final order, other than for the payment of money, of a court of this
 state.
- Notwithstanding the limitations of section 12.1-32-01, the defendantindividual may be
 sentenced to pay a fine in any amount deemed just by the court.
- An individual who willfully violates a lawful order of a court of this state requiring the
 individual to participate in the twenty-four seven sobriety program authorized in
- 15 sections 54-12-27 through 54-12-31 is guilty of a class B misdemeanor. If a law
- 16 <u>enforcement officer has reasonable cause to believe an individual has violated a lawful</u>
- 17 <u>order of a court of this state requiring the person to participate in the twenty-four seven</u>
- 18 sobriety program, the law enforcement officer may arrest the individual without a
- 19 warrant and take the individual into custody. An individual arrested under this
- 20 subsection may not be released on bail or on the individual's personal recognizance
- 21 <u>unless the individual has made a personal appearance before a magistrate.</u>
- 22 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
