## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SEC	TIOI	N 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
5	fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much of the		
6	sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of establishing a		
7	grant program to provide school district nursing services, for the biennium beginning July 1,		
8	2011, and ending June 30, 2013.		
9	1.	For	the purposes of this Act, school district nursing services include:
10		a.	Direct health care for acute injuries, illnesses, and chronic health conditions;
11		b.	Screening and referrals for health conditions;
12		C.	Management of medication administration;
13		d.	Services for students with special needs;
14		e.	Identification of, support for, and referral of students impacted by substance
15			abuse and physical abuse;
16		f.	Health education;
17		g.	The promotion of individual health and healthy school environments;
18		h.	The identification of health care needs that affect student achievement;
19		i.	Immunization monitoring; and
20		j.	Health care coverage monitoring.
21	2.	In order to be awarded a grant, a recipient must agree to match the amount of the	
22		grant on a dollar-for-dollar basis. A recipient is not limited in the source of its matching	
23		sha	re.

A recipient may use its grant to directly employ one or more individuals for the purpose 2 of providing school district nursing services or to contract for the provision of school 3 district nursing services with public or private entities. 4 4. Grants under this Act may not supplant existing school nursing services offered during 5 the 2011-12 school year but may be used to enhance existing school nursing services. 6 A recipient may be a school district, a group of school districts, or a regional education 5. 7 association. 8 6. The state department of health may not use more than five percent of the total amount 9 appropriated in this Act for administrative costs, including the costs of one full-time 10 equivalent employee position and related operating expenses.
