Engrossed HB 1424 with Senate Amendments creates a sales and use tax exemption for agrichemical tank cleaners and foam markers, expands the retail compensation allowance, and declares an emergency.

If enacted as an emergency measure, Eng. HB 1424 with Senate Amendments is expected to reduce state general fund and state aid distribution fund revenues by an estimated \$27,500 in the current 2009-11 biennium, and \$55,000 in the 2011-13 biennium, relative to the sales tax exemption for tank cleaners and foam markers.

Additionally, the bill expands compensation for retailers which is expected to reduce state general fund and state aid distribution fund revenues by approximately \$1.95 million during the final 18 months of the 2011-13 biennium. This provision is also expected to increase city sales tax revenues by an estimated \$217,400 by reducing the overall level of local compensation to retailers.
