HB 1188: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 20.1-01-25, 23-29-05.1, and 39-10-59 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to littering on game refuges or recreation areas, open burning, and depositing rubbish on highways; and to provide a penalty.

Was read the first time and referred to the Energy and Natural Resources Committee.

HB 1189: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-38-30 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to corporate income tax rates; and to provide an effective date.
