1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-59-22 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to electronic mail, file and print server administration, database administration,

3 application server, and hosting services.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-59-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 54-59-22. Required use of electronic mail, file and print server administration,

8 database administration, application server, and hosting services.

9 Each state agency and institution, excluding the legislative and judicial branches, <u>and</u> the
10 institutions under the control of the state board of higher education, the attorney general, and

11 any entity exempted by the office of management and budget after advisement by the-

12 information technology department, shall obtain electronic mail, file and print server

13 administration, database administration, storage, application server, and hosting services

14 through a delivery system established by the information technology department in conjunction

15 with the office of management and budget. The office of management and budget, after

16 receiving advice from the information technology department, shall establish policies and

17 guidelines for the delivery of services, including the transition from existing systems to

18 functional consolidation, with consideration given to the creation of efficiencies, cost-savings,

19 and improved quality of service. <u>The information technology department shall implement any</u>

20 <u>necessary policies, procedures, and information technology hardware related to the state data</u>

21 center to be in compliance with the most recently available criminal justice information services

22 <u>security policy from the United States federal bureau of investigation.</u>
