HOUSE RULES CHANGES RECOMMENDED BY THE LEGISLATIVE PROCEDURE AND ARRANGEMENTS COMMITTEE

1	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. House Rule 202 is amended as follows:
2	202. Member to preside in place of Speaker. The Speaker may leave the chair and
3	appoint a member to preside, but not for a longer time than one day, except by leave of the
4	House.
5	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. House Rule 306 is amended as follows:
6	306. Rules of debate. No member may speak more than twice on the same question
7	without leave of the House, nor more than once until every member choosing to speak on the
8	question pending has spoken. No member may speak for more than ten minutes the first time,
9	nor more than five minutes the second time. This rule does not apply to the Majority and
10	Minority Leaders and the chairman of the committee in charge of the bill, ernor to a spokesman
11	designated by that chairman.
12	SECTION 3. House Rule 339.1 is created as follows:
13	339.1. Voice votes. Except as provided in House Rule 340, or when a roll call vote is
14	requested under House Rule 320, or when a verification vote is requested under House
15	Rule 343, action that results in final disposition of a resolution must be taken by a voice vote
16	and the results must be recorded in the journal.
17	SECTION 4. Joint Rule 507.1 is created as follows:
18	507.1. Hearing of measures. Every bill and resolution referred to committee must be
19	scheduled for a hearing in committee, and a hearing must be held on the bill or resolution
20	before the appropriate deadline for reporting the bill or resolution back to the House. This rule
21	does not apply to a bill or resolution withdrawn either before being scheduled for a hearing or
