- 1 A BILL for an Act to require authorization of the purchase or lease of aircraft; to provide for the
- 2 use of department of transportation airplanes; to provide for the disposition of airplanes; to
- 3 provide legislative intent; to provide for budget section approval; to provide for a report to the
- 4 sixty-fourth legislative assembly; and to provide an appropriation.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1**.
- 7 Authorization to purchase or lease aircraft Legislative assembly or budget section
- 8 approval.
- A state agency or other entity of state government may not purchase or lease an aircraft
- 10 without specific authorization from the legislative assembly or the budget section of the
- 11 <u>legislative management if the legislative assembly is not in session. This section does not apply</u>
- 12 to aircraft purchased or leased by the office of the adjutant general or the university of North
- 13 Dakota school of aviation.
- 14 **SECTION 2.**
- 15 <u>Use of department of transportation airplanes.</u>
- 16 Upon request, the department of transportation shall provide air transportation services to
- other state agencies. Unless waived by the department, each agency using air transportation
- 18 <u>services from the department shall pay a user charge determined by the department of</u>
- 19 <u>transportation. The department shall give priority to requests for air transportation services from</u>
- 20 the attorney general's office when the request is for law enforcement purposes. The director of
- 21 the department of transportation shall allow employees of other state agencies to operate the
- 22 department's airplanes for official purposes if the employee is properly licensed and has the
- proper rating and type endorsement to operate the requested airplane.

1	SECTION 3. DISPOSITION OF DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AIRPLANES. The
2	director of the department of transportation shall dispose of, by sale or trade, the department's
3	1977 piper cheyenne airplane and the department's 1975 cessna skymaster airplane. If the
4	airplanes are sold, the proceeds from the sale of the airplanes must be remitted to the state
5	treasurer for deposit in the general fund. After June 30, 2014, the department may not use any
6	funds appropriated by the legislative assembly to maintain or operate the department's 1977
7	piper cheyenne airplane or the department's 1975 cessna skymaster airplane.
8	SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY AIRPLANE
9	LEASE - REPORT TO SIXTY-FOURTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. It is the intent of the
10	sixty-third legislative assembly that before June 30, 2017, North Dakota state university
11	discontinue the lease entered by the university for a KingAir B200 airplane and that North
12	Dakota state university provide a report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-fourth
13	legislative assembly regarding the status of its KingAir B200 airplane lease and efforts to utilize
14	other air transportation services.
15	SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - AIRPLANE
16	REPLACEMENT - BUDGET SECTION APPROVAL - ADVISORY COMMITTEE. There is
17	appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
18	appropriated, the sum of \$4,500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the
19	department of transportation for the purpose of purchasing replacement airplanes for the
20	department's airplane fleet, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
21	The department of transportation must receive budget section approval prior to expending any
22	funds appropriated under this section in excess of \$4,000,000. The funding provided in this
23	section is considered a one-time funding item.
24	During the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, the department of
25	transportation shall establish an airplane replacement advisory committee to advise the
26	department of transportation regarding the purchase of replacement airplanes authorized under
27	this section. The members of the advisory committee include:
28	1. The director of the department of transportation or the director's designee who shall
29	serve as chairman;

The director of the office of management and budget or the director's designee; and

The director of the aeronautics commission or the director's designee;

- 1 4. Two members of the legislative assembly appointed by the chairman of the legislative management.
- 3 The committee shall meet at the call of the chairman. The members of the committee who are
- 4 members of the legislative assembly are entitled to receive compensation and expense
- 5 reimbursement as provided under section 54-03-20 and reimbursement for mileage as provided
- 6 by law for state officers. The legislative council shall pay the compensation and expense
- 7 reimbursement for the legislative members.
