1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to transition payments for isolated school districts; to provide an effective
3 date; and to declare an emergency.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 **Isolated school districts - Transition payments.**

8 If during the 2010-11 school year a school district received payments as a result of section
9 15.1-27-15, as the section existed on June 30, 2011, and if that district is not eligible for the
10 factor established under subdivision j of subsection 1 of section 15.1-27-03.1, the district is
11 entitled to the following transition payments:

- 12 1. For the 2013-14 school year, an amount equal to that which the district would have
13 received under section 15.1-27-15, as the section existed on June 30, 2011;
- 14 2. For the 2014-15 school year, an amount equal to that which the district would have
15 received under section 15.1-27-15, as the section existed on June 30, 2011;
- 16 3. For the 2015-16 school year, an amount equal to seventy-five percent of that which
17 the district would have received under section 15.1-27-15, as the section existed on
18 June 30, 2011;
- 19 4. For the 2016-17 school year, an amount equal to fifty percent of that which the district
20 would have received under section 15.1-27-15, as the section existed on June 30,
21 2011; and
- 22 5. For the 2017-18 school year, an amount equal to twenty-five percent of that which the
23 district would have received under section 15.1-27-15, as the section existed on
24 June 30, 2011.

- 1 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective on July 1, 2013.
- 2 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
