- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 62.1-02-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to a firearm or dangerous weapon in a gaming site.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 62.1-02-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 62.1-02-04. Possession of firearm or dangerous weapon in liquor establishment or 7 gaming site prohibited - Penalty - Exceptions.

- 8 <u>1.</u> Any person<u>An individual</u> who enters or remains in that part of the establishment that is 9 set aside for the retail sale in an establishment engaged in the retail sale of alcoholic 10 beverages or used as a gaming site while in the possession of a firearm or dangerous 11 weapon is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 12 <u>2.</u> This section does not apply to:
- 13 <u>1.a.</u> A law enforcement officer.
- 14 <u>2.b.</u> The proprietor.
- 15 <u>3.c.</u> The proprietor's employee.
- A designee of the proprietor when the designee is displaying an unloaded firearm
  or dangerous weapon as a prize or sale item in a raffle or auction.
- 5.e. Private security personnel while on duty for the purpose of delivering or receiving
  moneys used at the liquor establishment or gaming site.
