- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of the feasibility and desirability
- 2 of participating in the provision of nontraditional healing therapies for posttraumatic stress,
- 3 traumatic brain injury, and other neurological conditions for North Dakota veterans and their
- 4 families.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - NONTRADITIONAL THERAPIES

7 FOR POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS, TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY, AND OTHER

8 **NEUROLOGICAL CONDITIONS.** During the 2013-14 interim, the legislative management shall

9 consider studying the feasibility and desirability of participating in the provision of nontraditional

10 healing therapies, including massage, healing touch, reflexology, stress management, yoga,

- and hyperbaric chamber treatments, for North Dakota veterans, military personnel, and their
- 12 families. If conducted, the study must also gather information regarding the needs of women
- 13 veterans. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together
- 14 with any legislation to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fourth legislative assembly.
