1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 and a new  
2 subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to disabled  
3 veterans and hunting fees; and to amend and reenact ~~subsection 6 of section~~  
4 ~~20.1-03-12~~subsection 1 of section 54-17.8-06 of the North Dakota Century Code as created by  
5 House Bill No. 1278, as approved by the sixty-third legislative assembly, relating to ~~and fishing~~  
6 ~~fees for disabled veterans~~the members of the North Dakota outdoor heritage advisory board.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

8 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
9 created and enacted as follows:

10 "Disabled veteran" means a veteran who has a one hundred percent  
11 service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or  
12 has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that brings the  
13 veteran's total disability ratio to one hundred percent as determined by the department  
14 of veterans' affairs.

15 ~~**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota~~  
16 ~~Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:~~

17 ~~6. For a resident fishing license, ten dollars, except that for a resident sixty-five years~~  
18 ~~or over or, a resident totally or permanently disabled, or a resident disabled veteran,~~  
19 ~~the license fee is three dollars.~~

20 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
21 created and enacted as follows:

22 For a resident disabled veteran combined general game, habitat stamp, small game,  
23 and fur-bearer license, three dollars.

1       **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 54-17.8-06 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code as created by House Bill No. 1278, as approved by the sixty-third legislative  
3 assembly, is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 4           1. There is created a North Dakota outdoor heritage advisory board consisting of  
5 twelve members. The governor shall appoint representatives from each of the  
6 groups listed in this section based upon recommendations made by the  
7 appropriate group. The advisory board consists of:
- 8           a. Four members from the agriculture community. The governor shall appoint  
9 one member from the North Dakota farm bureau, North Dakota farmers  
10 union, the North Dakota stockmen's association, and the North Dakota grain  
11 growers association.
  - 12           b. Two members from the energy industry. The governor shall appoint one  
13 member from the North Dakota petroleum council and one member from the  
14 lignite energy council.
  - 15           c. Four members from the conservation community. ~~The governor shall~~  
16 ~~appoint one member from ducks unlimited of North Dakota, the North~~  
17 ~~Dakota natural resources trust fund, the North Dakota chapter of pheasants~~  
18 ~~forever, and the conservation community at large.~~
  - 19           d. One member from the business community from the greater North Dakota  
20 chamber.
  - 21           e. One member from the North Dakota recreation and park association.
