- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 55-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to state historical society jurisdiction over Fort Abraham Lincoln state
- 3 park; and to amend and reenact section 55-02-01.3 and subsection 9 of section 55-08-01.3 of
- 4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to administration of Fort Abraham Lincoln state park.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 55-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 Society to have jurisdiction over Fort Abraham Lincoln state park.
- 9 The society has jurisdiction over the administration and operation of Fort Abraham Lincoln
- 10 state park. The director of the parks and recreation department may operate a campground and
- 11 <u>trails at Fort Abraham Lincoln state park under the supervision of the society.</u>
- 12 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 55-02-01.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 13 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 14 55-02-01.3. Director to advise director of parks and recreation department.
- The Except for administration and operation of Fort Abraham Lincoln state park, the director
- 16 shall advise the director of the parks and recreation department on matters pertaining to the
- 17 preservation of historical and archaeological artifacts and historical structures in the state parks.
- 18 These duties may be performed by the director's duly designated representative.
- 19 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 9 of section 55-08-01.3 of the North Dakota
- 20 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9. SeekExcept for administration and operation of Fort Abraham Lincoln state park, seek
- the advice of the director of the state historical society on matters relating to history,
- prehistory, and paleontology of the state parks.
