5	SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 16.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

10	the state of disaster or emergency is reasonably likely to substantially interfere with the election.
11	The period of the postponement of an election may not exceed thirty days from the regularly

13	may take any action necessary or expedient to facilitate the conduct of the postponed election.
