- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a department of commerce North Dakota tribal tourism alliance
- 3 program; and to provide an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 North Dakota tribal tourism alliance program.

8 <u>The department shall establish and administer a North Dakota tribal tourism alliance</u>

9 program to assist tribal governments in the promotion of tourism on Indian reservations in the

10 state. As part of the program, the department may provide grants to tribal governments of Indian

11 reservations in this state for the purpose of promoting tourism within the Indian reservations.

12 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general 13 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$6,000,000, or so much of the 14 sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of implementing the 15 North Dakota tribal tourism alliance program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and 16 ending June 30, 2015. Of the amount appropriated under this section, the department may use 17 no more than \$1,000,000 for administration of the program and no more than \$5,000,000 for 18 grants, of which the department may not distribute more than \$1,000,000 to any one Indian 19 reservation during the biennium.
