1 A BILL for an Act to provide for an appropriation to the state historical society for archeological
2 surveys.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY - ARCHEOLOGICAL**
5 **SURVEYS.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury,
6 not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$4,999, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to
7 the state historical society for the purpose of conducting historical, cultural, and archeological
8 surveys in the Killdeer battlefield study area, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and
9 ending June 30, 2015. The state historical society shall reduce its expenditures relating to the
10 general fund appropriations provided under this section by any grant funds received by the state
11 historical society for the purposes identified in this section. The state historical society may not
12 survey the private property without a written agreement with the private landowner which
13 defines the scope of the survey and the conditions of access to the property and provides any
14 artifacts discovered are the property of the landowner. Following the survey, any preservation of
15 the site is in the discretion of the landowner.
