1 A concurrent resolution urging the United States Department of the Interior's Bureau of
2 Reclamation and North Dakota's Congressional Delegation to work together to find a solution
3 that allows people occupying lots around Lake Tschida under bureau-issued permits to freely
4 transfer their permits and to leave nonpermanent structures, such as mobile homes, on their
5 lots.

6 **WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Reclamation recently announced new policies that will restrict
7 the transferability of permits to lots around Lake Tschida and that will require removal from
8 those lots of nonpermanent structures, such as mobile homes; and

9 **WHEREAS**, these new policies change a half century of past policies; and

10 **WHEREAS**, these new polices adversely affect, and in many instances substantially so,
11 economic and other decisions made by permitholders in reliance on the continuation of bureau
12 policies; and

13 **WHEREAS**, businesses from the small towns near Lake Tschida, as well as officials in
14 those towns, are concerned about the adverse consequences for them if the bureau's new
15 policies are not rescinded or revised; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Lake Tschida permitholders have sought to work with the bureau and North
17 Dakota's Congressional Delegation to find an amicable resolution to the concerns of all
18 interests;

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**
20 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

21 That the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly urges the United States Department of the
22 Interior's Bureau of Reclamation and North Dakota's Congressional Delegation to work together
23 to find a solution that allows people occupying lots around Lake Tschida under bureau-issued
