4	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 26.1-02.1-05 of the North Dakota
5	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
6	1. <u>a.</u> A violation of section 26.1-02.1-02.1 is-a:
7	(1) A class A felony if the value of any property or services retained exceeds
8	fifty thousand dollars;
9	(2) A class B felony if the value of any property or services attempted to be
0	obtained exceeds fifty thousand dollars;
11	(3) A class B felony if the value of any property or services retained exceeds
2	ten thousand dollars, a but does not exceed fifty thousand dollars;
3	(4) A class C felony if the value of any property or services attempted to be
4	obtained exceeds ten thousand dollars but does not exceed fifty thousand
5	<u>dollars;</u>
6	(5) A class C felony if the value of any property or services retained exceeds
7	fiveone thousand dollars; but does not exceed ten thousand dollars; and a
8	(6) A class A misdemeanor in all other cases.
9	bFor purposes of this section, the value of any property and services must be
20	determined in accordance with subsection 6 of section 12.1-23-05.
