- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the attorney general;
- 2 to amend and reenact sections 54-12-11 and 54-59-22 of the North Dakota Century
- 3 Code, relating to the salary of the attorney general and to required use of information
- 4 technology services; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the attorney general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the attorney general, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

31 2015-17 biennium. The attorney general shall report to the appropriations committees of the

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1 sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning 2 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. 3 SECTION 3. ATTORNEY GENERAL REFUND FUND TRANSFER TO THE GENERAL 4 **FUND - EXEMPTION.** Notwithstanding section 54-12-18, the attorney general may retain the 5 balance in the attorney general refund fund that would otherwise be transferred to the general 6 fund on June 30, 2013. 7 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-12-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 amended and reenacted as follows: 9 54-12-11. Salary of attorney general. 10 The annual salary of the attorney general is one hundred thirty-fourforty-twoforty-three 11 thousand enethreesix hundred thirty-fivefoureighty-five dollars through June 30, 20122014, and 12 one hundred thirty-eightforty-sixforty-seven thousand enefivenine hundred fifty-nineseventy-13 threeninety-six dollars thereafter. 14 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 54-59-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is 15 amended and reenacted as follows: 16 54-59-22. Required use of electronic mail, file and print server administration, 17 database administration, application server, and hosting services. 18 Each state agency and institution, excluding the legislative and judicial branches, the 19 institutions under the control of the state board of higher education, the public employees-20 retirement system, the retirement and investment office, the attorney general, and any entity-21 exempted by the office of management and budget after advisement by the information-22 technology department, shall obtain electronic mail, file and print server administration, 23 database administration, storage, application server, and hosting services through a delivery-24 system established by the information technology department in conjunction with the office of 25 management and budget. The office of management and budget, after receiving advice from-26 the information technology department, shall establish policies and guidelines for the delivery of 27 services, including the transition from existing systems to functional consolidation, with-28 consideration given to the creation of efficiencies, cost-savings, and improved quality of service. 29 SECTION 5. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION - LIMITED AUTHORIZATION. The 30 full-time equivalent line item in section 1 of this Act includes one full-time equivalent position for

computerized business projects. This position is authorized only for the biennium beginning

- 1 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. The Attorney General shall reevaluate the position and
- determine if the position will be requested as part of the agency's 2015-17 biennium budget
- 3 request as an optional item.
- 4 **SECTION 6. EMERGENCY.** Section 3 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
