- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-10-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to tuition for dependents of disabled veterans.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **15-10-18.3. Free tuition in North Dakota institutions of higher education.**

7 Any dependent, as defined in section 15-10-18.2 upon being duly accepted for enrollment

8 into any undergraduate degree or certificate program of a North Dakota state institution of

9 higher education, must be allowed to obtain a bachelor's degree or certificate of completion, for

10 so long as the dependent is eligible, free of any tuition and fee charges; provided, however, that

11 <u>if</u> the bachelor's degree or certificate of completion is earned within a forty-five-month or

12 ten-semester period or its equivalent; and further provided that if tuition and fee charges shalldo

13 not include costs for aviation flight charges or expenses. Once a personan individual qualifies

14 as a dependent under sections 15-10-18.2 and 15-10-18.3, the dependent may not be

15 disqualified from the benefits of this sectiondue to such an occurrence as:

- 16 <u>1.</u> <u>Due to</u> the return of the prisoner of war or person;
- 17 <u>2.</u> <u>Due to the return of the individual missing in action; or</u>
- 18 <u>3.</u> Because the veteran through whom the benefit was obtained had a one hundred
- 19 percent service-connected disability at the time of death.
