- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
- 2 to publication of park district board proceedings.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1.
- 5 <u>Publication of park district board proceedings Vote.</u>
- Beginning with the 2014 biennial municipal elections, and every four years thereafter, all
- 7 <u>cities in North Dakota, regardless of their form of government, shall put on the ballot as a</u>
- 8 separate question whether the minutes of its park district board of park commissioners must be
- 9 <u>published in the city's official newspaper. If voters approve publication, the board of park</u>
- 10 commissioners shall, within seven days after each meeting, give the official newspaper, for
- 11 <u>publication, the complete minutes, or a complete summary showing the substantive actions</u>
- 12 taken at the meeting. Roll call votes must be published, but may be indicated as "unanimous"
- when appropriate. A list of the individual expenditures issued by the park district and approved
- by the governing body of the board of park commissioners, showing the payee and the amount
- 15 of each such expenditure, must be published. However, employee salary disbursements need
- 16 not be published if the board of park commissioners elects to publish an annual salary schedule
- for each employee. When applicable, the minutes may be labeled as being published subject to
- 18 review and revision. The minutes must continue to be published until disapproved at a
- 19 <u>succeeding quadrennial election</u>.
