- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 57-06-17.5 and a new subsection to section
- 2 57-51-02.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a new natural gas gathering and

3 collection systems property tax exemption and oil and gas gross production tax exemption; and

4 to provide an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. Section 57-06-17.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted
7 as follows:

8 <u>57-06-17.5. New natural gas gathering and collection systems property tax</u>

9 exemption.

10 <u>A natural gas gathering pipeline of a three-inch [7.62-centimeter] diameter or smaller, or</u>

11 having a pressure of twenty-five pounds per square inch [1.75 per kilograms per square

12 <u>centimeter] or less, and its associated equipment, or a natural gas or natural gas liquids</u>

13 collection system which is initially placed in service on or between January 1, 2013, and

14 December 31, 2017, is exempt from property taxes for the first taxable year after the line is

15 initially placed in service, and the taxable valuation as otherwise determined by law on the

16 gathering pipeline or collection system and the associated equipment must be reduced by:

17 <u>1.</u> <u>Seventy-five percent for the second taxable year of operation of the gathering pipeline.</u>

- 18 <u>2.</u> <u>Fifty percent for the third taxable year of operation of the gathering pipeline.</u>
- <u>Twenty five percent for the fourth taxable year of operation of the gathering pipeline or</u>
 <u>collection system.</u>

21 After the fourth taxable year of operation the gathering and collection systems are no longer

22 <u>exempt, in any way, from payment of full property taxes as otherwise determined by law. For</u>

23 purposes of this section, "initially placed in service" includes both new construction and

24 substantial expansion of a preexisting gathering or collection system, and "substantial

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1 expansion" means a capacity increase of twenty percent or more. Associated equipment 2 includes compression, liquid separation facilities, and any other equipment absolutely 3 necessary to gather or collect natural gas and natural gas liquids. A "collection system" is a 4 system that collects at least seventy-five percent of the gas and natural gas liquids from the well 5 for compression to liquid or dense phase fluid for use as fuel or transport to a processing facility. 6 production of petrochemicals or fertilizer, or conversion to liquid fuels. Natural gas processing 7 and other natural gas liquid refining plants or facilities are expressly excluded from this section. 8 SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 57-51-02.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is 9 created and enacted as follows: 10 An operator who collects natural gas at a well site by natural gas gathering line. 11 electrical generator, or collection system described in section 38-08-06.4 shall be 12 entitled to an exemption from the tax imposed under this section for a period of one 13 year from the day the natural gas is first collected. 14 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this Act is effective for taxable years 15 beginning after December 31, 2012. Section 2 of this Act is effective for taxable events 16 occurring after June 30, 2013.
