SB 2282 requires that all school districts offer educational services to students in grades K-12. Districts unable to meet the requirement must reorganize or dissolve by July 1, 2014. Districts unable to meet these requirements are not eligible to receive state aid payments.

Section 1 requires, by July 1, 2014, that all school districts provide educational services to students in grades K-12 and districts that do comply must either reorganize or dissolve by July 1, 2014, and further districts that do not meet the requirements may not receive state aid payments. Compliance with the provisions of this section should have no fiscal impact on state revenue or expenditures and will require no state appropriation. Similarly, counties, cities and townships should experience no fiscal impact in relation to this bill. In the case of school districts, no fiscal impact is anticipated beyond minor unquantifiable costs related to efforts to carry out the required provisions of the bill.
