This bill is requesting an increase for the annual license renewal fees and the license application fees for the ND State Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

Current law maximizes annual license renewal fees and license application fees at \$200.00. These changes are necessary to cover the increasing costs of general operation and expenses of past and future disciplinary proceedings.
