1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of the state's health care

2 delivery system.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - HEALTH CARE DELIVERY

5 SYSTEM. During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall consider continuing its

6 ongoing study of the needs and challenges of the North Dakota health care delivery system.

7 The study may include monitoring the implementation of the federal Affordable Care Act,

8 examining medicaid expansion and medicaid reform, and considering the feasibility of

- 9 developing a state-based plan for a health care model that will comply with federal health care
- 10 reform in a manner that will provide high-quality access and affordable care for North Dakota
- 11 citizens. The university of North Dakota school of medicine and health sciences advisory council
- 12 shall make periodic reports to the legislative management on the status of the biennial report
- 13 developed pursuant to section 15-52-04. The legislative management shall report its findings
- 14 and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
- 15 recommendations, to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly.
