- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of special assessments.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS. During 4 the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the use of special 5 assessments by political subdivisions. The study must include how special assessment and 6 improvement districts across the state are determined and created, how administrative costs 7 are calculated in determining project costs, how project costs are distributed among affected 8 property owners, and how excess revenues and fees collected by the special assessment and 9 improvement districts are handled. The legislative management shall report its findings and 10 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
