1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-24-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the minimum age for snowmobile operators.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-24-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 39-24-09.1. Operation by individuals at least twelve years of age- Minimum age. 7 An individual under the age of ten may not operate a snowmobile unless the individual 1. 8 operates the snowmobile on private land. An individual ten or eleven years of age may 9 not operate a snowmobile unless the individual isoperates the snowmobile on private 10 land or unless the individual is in the presence of a parent or guardian and the 11 individual pursuant to chapter 30.1-27, has completed a snowmobile safety training 12 course as prescribed by the director of the parks and recreation department pursuant 13 to chapter 28-32, and has received the appropriate snowmobile safety certificate 14 issued by the director of the parks and recreation department of transportation. 15 An individual twelve years of age and over may not operate a snowmobile unless the <u>2.</u> 16 individual is in possession of a valid driver's license, operates the snowmobile on 17 private land, or unless the individual has completed a snowmobile safety training 18 course as prescribed by the director of the parks and recreation department pursuant 19 to chapter 28-32 and has received the appropriate snowmobile safety certificate 20 issued by the director of the parks and recreation department of transportation. 21 The failure of an operator to exhibit a snowmobile safety certificate upon demand to 3. 22 any official authorized to enforce this chapter is presumptive evidence that the 23 individual is not the holder of the certificate.
