- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to headlamps on motorcycles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-21-01. When lighted lamps are required.**

- Subject to the exceptions for parked vehicles, every vehicle upon a highway within this
 state must display lighted headlamps, taillamps, and illuminating devices as required
 in this chapter for different classes of vehicles as follows:
- 10 1. <u>a.</u> At any time from sunset to sunrise, <u>at all times for a motorcycle</u>, and every farm
 11 tractor upon a highway within this state at any time from a half hour after sunset
 12 to a half hour before sunrise <u>for a farm tractor</u>;
- 13 2. b. At any time when it is raining, snowing, sleeting, or hailing or during other
 14 adverse driving conditions and these conditions do not render a person or vehicle
 15 on the highway clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand feet [304.8
 16 meters] ahead; or
- 17 3. <u>c.</u> At any other time when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog, or other
 18 conditions, or when there is insufficient light to render a person or vehicle on the
 19 highway clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand feet [304.8 meters]
 20 ahead.
- 21 <u>2.</u> Stoplights, turn signals, and other signaling devices must be lighted as prescribed for
 22 the use of these devices.
