- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 54-01-29 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to negotiation for the transfer of excess lands around Lake Sakakawea and Lake Oahe.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 54-01-29 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as

5 follows:

## 6 <u>54-01-29. Negotiation for the transfer of excess lands - Generally.</u>

- 7 <u>1.</u> The state board of university and school lands shall negotiate with the United States
- 8 army corps of engineers for the return of excess lands around Lake Sakakawea above
  9 elevation 1.854 feet mean sea level and excess lands around Lake Oahe above 1.617

10 feet mean sea level to the state for transfer to the appropriate persons.

- 11 <u>2.</u> If the United States army corps of engineers transfers land surrounding Lake
- 12 Sakakawea or Lake Oahe to the state government, the ownership of land located
- 13 within a Native American reservation is to be determined by the tribe and the
- 14 <u>ownership of land not located within a reservation is to be determined by the</u>
- 15 appropriate county. The state board of university and school lands shall accept
- 16 <u>temporary transfer of the land.</u>
