3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. VIRTUAL PUBLIC SCHOOLS - STUDY BY SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC 5 INSTRUCTION - REPORT.

- The superintendent of public instruction shall study the expansion of online learning opportunities for kindergarten, elementary, and high school students, through the development and implementation of a state operated online virtual school, that is recognized as a public school and which is free and accessible to any student in this state. The virtual school must make available all courses required of approved schools in accordance with chapter 15.1-21 and provide students with access to a wide array of electives and advanced placement or dual credit courses.
- The superintendent of public instruction may appoint a committee, work groups, task forces, and subcommittees, as necessary, to provide or obtain information required in conjunction with this study.
- The superintendent of public instruction shall report any findings and
 recommendations to an interim committee designated by the legislative management.
