- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-09-11 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to qualifications for licensure as an electrician.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-09-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:
 43-09-11. Qualifications.
- 7 <u>1.</u> An applicant for an electrician's license must have the following experience and training:
 - a. For licensure as a master electrician, an applicant must have completed one year's experience as a licensed journeyman electrician.
- 11 2. b. For licensure as a journeyman electrician, an applicant must have:
 - a. (1) Completed eight thousand hours' experience in installing and repairing electrical wiring, apparatus, and equipment, which experience may not be obtained in less than three years.
 - b. (2) Effective for an applicant who registered with the board as an apprentice after January 31, 2008, completed at least one of the following:
 - (1) (a) Successfully completed apprenticeship training approved by the federal bureau of apprenticeship and training and completed eight thousand hours' experience in installing and repairing electrical wiring, apparatus, and equipment.
 - (2) (b) Successfully completed an appropriate course of study, which may not be less than two years or the equivalent of two years, at a board-approved institution of higher education and completed eight thousand hours' experience in installing and repairing electrical wiring,

1		apparatus, and equipment. The board may determine equivalent
2		hours of education that may be applied as a credit against the eight
3		thousand hours' experience requirement under this paragraph.
4	3.	c. For licensure as a class B electrician, eighteen months' experience in farmstead
5		or residential wiring.
6	<u>2.</u>	The board shall adopt rules to provide credit for military service, training, or education
7		toward the requirements for an electrician's license upon submission of documentary
8		verification of the service, training, or education, including a DD Form 214 and DD
9		Form 2586.
