1 A memorial resolution for deceased members of the Senate of North Dakota.

2 **WHEREAS**, God has welcomed to their eternal home our former colleagues:

3 Ray David, who served in the 48th through the 52nd Legislative Assemblies, from District 38,
4 died September 30, 2014;

5 Joe Keller, who served in the 50th through the 53rd Legislative Assemblies, from District 33,
6 died October 23, 2013;

7 Ed Kringstad, who served in the 54th through the 57th Legislative Assemblies, from
8 District 49, and in the 58th and 59th Legislative Assemblies, from District 35, died May 4, 2013;

9 Emil T. Nelson, who served in the 34th and 35th Legislative Assemblies and in the 38th and
10 39th Legislative Assemblies, from District 24, died January 13, 2014;

11 Michael Polovitz, who served in the 57th and 58th Legislative Assemblies, from District 42,
12 died December 14, 2013;

13 Claire A. Sandness, who served in the 43rd through the 46th Legislative Assemblies, from
14 District 28, died August 3, 2014;

15 Jay Schultz, who served in the 43rd and 44th Legislative Assemblies, from District 32, died

17 John O. Syverson, who served in the 58th and 59th Legislative Assemblies, from District 45,
