FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1107

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-17.3-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to public safety answering point service by the division of state radio; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 37-17.3-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 37-17.3-09. Public safety answering point service and fees.
- 8 The division may provide 911 primary public safety answering point services to a political
- 9 subdivision with that has a population of fewer than twenty thousand and twenty-five thousand at
- 10 the time an agreement is signed for services with the division. The division shall charge the
- 11 apportioned amount consistent with the actual costs of providing the primary service per
- 12 telephone access line and wireless access line for 911 services provided to political
- 13 subdivisions. The fee for 911 wirelessprimary public safety answering point services must be
- 14 charged to and paid by the political subdivision receiving services from the division under this
- 15 section from and after the date of the agreement entered into by the political subdivision or its
- 16 designee under section 57-40.6-05, whether the date of that agreement is before or after-
- 17 April 4, 2003. The division may provide primary public safety answering point services and other
- 18 <u>public safety answering point related services during emergencies and other times of need as</u>
- 19 agreed in a mutual aid agreement. Charges for services must be specified in the mutual aid
- 20 <u>agreement</u>. Each <u>countypolitical subdivision</u> currently receiving <u>911</u><u>primary public safety</u>
- 21 <u>answering point</u> services from the division shall abide by the standards established by law.
- **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
