10	SECTION 2. ADJUTANT GENERAL - VALLEY STATE UNIVERSITY - STATE DISASTER
11	<b>RELIEF FUND.</b> The operating expenses line item in subdivision 9 of section 1 of this Act
12	includes \$5,000,000 from the state disaster relief fund. The capital assets line item in
13	subdivision 6 of section 1 of this Act includes \$3,000,000 from the state disaster relief fund.
14	SECTION 3. EXEMPTION - TRANSFER - EMERGENCY COMMISSION CONTINGENCY
15	FUND TO COMMISSION ON LEGAL COUNSEL FOR INDIGENTS. Notwithstanding the
16	provisions of section 54-16-04 and 54-16-09, which require emergency commission and budget
17	section approval, the office of management and budget shall transfer spending authority of
18	\$200,000 from the state contingencies appropriation in the emergency commission contingency
19	fund line item in section 1 of chapter 15 of the 2013 Session Laws to the commission on legal
20	counsel for indigents for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending
21	June 30, 2015.

**SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
