4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 41-04-34 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- A stop order is effective for six months after the time it is received, but it lapses after fourteen calendar days if the original order was oral and was not confirmed in writinga
 record within that period. A stop order may be renewed for additional six-month periods by a writingrecord given to the bank within a period during which the stop order is effective.
