1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to publishing and preserving statements of interests.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

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6 **16.1-09-05.** Powers and duties of the secretary of state and county and city auditors.

- <u>1.</u> The secretary of state, or the county or city auditor, when appropriate shall:
- **1.** <u>a.</u> Accept and file any statement submitted pursuant to this chapter.
- 9 2. b. Make statements filed available for public inspection and copying during regular
 10 office hours. A reasonable fee may be charged to cover the cost of copying.
 11 Proceeds from any fees charged must be deposited in the general fund of the
 12 appropriate governmental entity.
- 13 <u>— 3. Make each statement available on the internet to the public free of charge within</u>
 14 seven days after filing.
- 154. c.Preserve statements filed under this chapter for the term of office to which the16person making disclosure is elected or appointed or until a new statement is filed-17and preserve statements filed pursuant to this chapter by those candidates who-18are not elected or appointed for a period of one yearat least ten years after the19date of receipt.
- 20 2. The secretary of state shall make each statement filed under this chapter with the
 21 secretary of state available on the internet to the public free of charge within fourteen
 22 days after filing.
