The next of kin is responsible for providing to the state forensic examiner or the examiner's designee satisfactory proof of relationship to the deceased and contact information for notification of the autopsy results. The state forensic examiner or the examiner's designee shall make a good faith effort to notify the next of kin using the provided contact information within seventy-two hours after the report of death is completed"
