## REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2025

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of  
2 veterans' affairs.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
7 other income, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of defraying the expenses of  
8 the department of veterans' affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending  
9 June 30, 2019, as follows:

3       **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - SERVICE DOGS.** There is appropriated out of any  
4 moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of  
5 \$50,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs for  
6 the purpose of training up to four service dogs to assist North Dakota veterans with post  
7 traumatic stress disorder, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
