- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to duties of the secretary of state; and to amend and reenact section
- 3 39-34-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to regulation of transportation network
- 4 companies.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-34-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 **39-34-06. Controlling authority.**

9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, transportation network companies and 10 transportation network company drivers are governed exclusively by this chapter and, chapter 11 26.1-40.1, section 2 of this Act, and any rules adopted consistent with this chapter, adopted 12 consistent with section 2 of this Act, and adopted by the insurance commissioner under chapter 13 26.1-40.1. A political subdivision may not impose a tax on, or require a license for, a 14 transportation network company or a transportation network company driver or subject a 15 transportation network company to the political subdivision's rate, entry, operational, or other 16 requirements. A political subdivision may prohibit a transportation network company from-17 operating without a state permit within the jurisdiction of the political subdivision. 18 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 54-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 19 and enacted as follows: 20 Transportation network company - Permit - Rules. 21 A person may not operate a transportation network company in this state without a permit 22 issued under this section. The secretary of state shall issue a permit to each applicant that 23 meets the requirements for a transportation network company. The secretary of state may adopt

24 <u>rules necessary to implement this section.</u>
