- 5 **WHEREAS**, joining the prosperity states compact allows member states to create
- 6 prosperity districts; and
- WHEREAS, prosperity districts are areas in which economic freedom is maximized by
- 8 reducing regulations and taxes to promote the economic growth of a region; and
- 9 **WHEREAS**, multiple states have introduced legislation to consider joining the prosperity
- 10 states compact;
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
- 12 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- That the Legislative Management consider studying the feasibility and desirability of joining
- 14 the prosperity states compact, including a comprehensive review of other states that have
- adopted the compact and the benefits provided to those states by establishing prosperity
- 16 districts under the compact; and
- 17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 19 the Sixty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
