1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
2 society.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that
8 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

10 **SECTION 3. REVOLVING FUND - APPROPRIATION.** All fees collected by the state
11 historical society and deposited in the revolving fund established pursuant to section 55-03-04
12 are appropriated to the state historical society for the purposes provided in chapter 55-03, for
13 the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

14 **SECTION 4. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS - APPROPRIATION.** All gifts, grants,
15 devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the state historical society and
16 deposited with the state treasurer pursuant to section 55-01-04 are appropriated to the state
17 historical society for the purposes provided in section 55-01-04, for the biennium beginning
18 July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
