

## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

1       **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Senate Rule 320 is amended as follows:

2       **320. Roll call vote.** ~~Except as required by the Constitution or these rules, a~~ roll call vote  
3 ~~may not~~must be ordered ~~unless~~when requested by one-sixth of those members present or  
4 when otherwise required by the Constitution or these rules. When a recorded roll call vote is  
5 ~~ordered pursuant to this rule~~held, the results must be printed in the journal in their entirety.

6       **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Senate Rule 348 is amended as follows:

7       **348. Motion for reconsideration.**

8       1. Any member may move for reconsideration of a question if any of the following apply:

9           a. The member voted on the prevailing side of the question ("prevailing side of the  
10           question" is the side that voted "aye" on a question that passed, and "nay" on a  
11           question that failed);

12           b. The member did not vote on the question; or

13           c. The member voted on the question and the ayes and nays were not recorded.

14       2. A motion to reconsider must be decided by a majority vote of the members-elect,  
15       except that a motion to reconsider adoption of an amendment must be decided by a  
16       majority vote of the members present.

17       3. In the case of a bill, resolution, or amendment to the Constitution, the motion to  
18       reconsider, if made after the end of the next legislative day following the action on the  
19       measure, requires a two-thirds vote of the members-elect.

20       4. The vote by which any measure passed or failed to pass may not be reconsidered  
21       more than once in any legislative day. For purposes of this subsection, a clincher  
22       motion that fails is not a motion to reconsider.

23       5. No motion to reconsider may be made unless the matter is in possession of the  
24       Senate.

25       6. ~~Determination~~Except when a roll call vote is required under Senate Rule 320,  
26       determination of any vote required under this rule must be by a verification vote.

27       **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** House Rule 348 is amended as follows:

28       **348. Motion for reconsideration.**

29       1. Any member may move for reconsideration of a question if any of the following apply:

- 1           a. The member voted on the prevailing side of the question ("prevailing side of a  
2           question" is the side that voted "aye" on a question that passed, and "nay" on a  
3           question that failed);
- 4           b. The member did not vote on the question; or
- 5           c. The member voted on the question and the ayes and nays were not recorded.
- 6        2. A motion to reconsider must be decided by a majority vote of the members-elect,  
7        except that a motion to reconsider adoption of an amendment must be decided by a  
8        majority vote of the members present.
- 9        3. In the case of a bill, resolution, or amendment to the Constitution, the motion to  
10        reconsider, if made after the end of the next legislative day following the action on the  
11        measure, requires a two-thirds vote of the members-elect.
- 12       4. The vote by which any measure passed or failed to pass may not be reconsidered  
13       more than once in any legislative day. For purposes of this subsection, a clincher  
14       motion that fails is not a motion to reconsider.
- 15       5. No motion to reconsider may be made unless the matter is in possession of the  
16       House.
- 17       6. Except when a roll call vote is ~~requested~~required under House Rule 320,  
18       determination of any vote required under this rule must be by a verification vote.
