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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state

treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and

other income, to the veterans' home for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the

9 veterans' home, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, as follows:

The 2019-21 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2021-23 biennium. The veterans' home shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-seventh legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.

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1 SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - SOLDIERS' HOME FUND - ADMINISTRATOR 2 HOUSING STIPEND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$48,000 3 from the soldiers' home fund for providing a \$2,000 monthly housing stipend to the veterans' 4 home administrator for housing costs off the veterans' home campus, for the biennium 5 beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. 6 SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - SOLDIERS' HOME FUND - ONE-TIME FUNDING. 7 The estimated income line item in Section 1 of this Act includes \$485,350\$524,050 of one-time 8 funding from the soldiers' home fund, of which \$99,400 is for equipment, \$100,000-\$138,700 is 9 for a flooring project, \$233,450 is for the demolition of the administrator's residence, and 10 \$52,500 is for security system upgrades, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending 11 June 30, 2021. 12 SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - LINE ITEM TRANSFER - 2017-19 BIENNIUM - NURSE CALL 13 **SYSTEM UPGRADE.** Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, at the request of the veterans' home 14 administrator during the 2017-19 biennium, the office of management and budget shall transfer 15 the sum of \$68,000 of estimated income from the soldiers' home fund from the operating 16 expenses line item to the capital assets line item of the veterans' home for the purpose of the 17 nurse call system upgrade authorized by the 65th legislative assembly. The \$68,000 of funding 18 transferred in this section and the \$82,500 from the soldiers' home fund appropriated in 19 section 1 of chapter 32 of the 2017 Session Laws for the nurse call system upgrade, for a total 20 of \$150,500, are not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds are available for 21 the nurse call system upgrade during the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 22 2021.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. Section 5 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
