- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 4.1-47 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to noxious weed certification; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 4.1-47 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Noxious weed certification Gravel and sand pits.
- If requested by any person needing certification, a county weed board may certify.
 based on standards set by the commissioner after consulting with representatives of county or city weed boards, gravel, scoria, topsoil, or sand surface mining operations
- 10 <u>are not contaminated with noxious weeds.</u>
- 11 2. The commissioner may adopt a schedule of fees that county weed boards may charge
 12 for inspecting, testing, analyzing, and certifying gravel, scoria, topsoil, or sand surface
 13 mining operations.
- 3. Certification of gravel, scoria, topsoil, or sand surface mining operations as being free
 from contamination of noxious weeds is not a warranty of any kind as to the quality of
 the gravel, scoria, topsoil, or sand from an inspected and certified location.
- 17 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
