1	A BILL-for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 6-09 of the North Dakota
2	Century Code, relating to the development and implementation of a skilled workforce student
3	loan repayment program; to provide a continuing appropriation; to provide for a transfer; to
4	provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency. for an Act to create and enact two
5	new sections to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the development
6	and implementation of a skilled workforce student loan repayment program and a skilled
7	workforce scholarship program; to provide continuing appropriations; to provide for transfers; to
8	provide for reports to the legislative management; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

10	—SEC	CTION 1. A new section to chapter 6-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
11	and ena	cted as follows:
12	— <u>Skil</u>	led workforce student loan repayment program - Development and
13	impleme	entation.
14	<u>-1.</u>	The Bank of North Dakota shall adopt rules to develop, implement, promote, and
15		administer a skilled workforce student loan repayment program in conjunction with the
16		North Dakota university system and the North Dakota workforce development council
17		with the intent of attracting and retaining individuals for professional or technical skills
18		in high demand in this state.
19	<u>2.</u>	The North Dakota workforce development council in cooperation with job service North
20		Dakota shall use available labor market information to determine annually the eligible
21		high demand and emerging occupations in this state.
22	<u> 3.</u>	The North Dakota university system and the North Dakota workforce development
23		council shall compile a list of qualifying educational programs by April first of each

year. Qualifying educational programs may include degree or certificate programs.

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1	<u>4.</u>	Graduates of qualifying educational programs from institutions or entities in this state
2		may apply for the skilled workforce student loan repayment program. To be eligible to
3		receive student loan repayment grants under the program, the applicant:
4		a. Must have successfully completed a qualifying educational program from a Bank
5		of North Dakota-approved institution or entity after January 1, 2019;
6		b. Must have maintained at least a 2.75 grade point average, based on a
7		4.0 grading system;
8		c. Must have a student loan with the Bank of North Dakota or other participating
9		lender:
10		d. Following completion of a qualifying educational program must remain and work
11		in this state in an eligible high-demand or emerging occupation; and
12		e. Must have met and shall continue to meet any requirements established by rule.
13	<u> </u>	The Bank of North Dakota shall adopt rules to ensure compliance with residency and
14		occupation requirements after completion of the qualifying educational program.
15	<u>6.</u>	The Bank of North Dakota shall distribute student loan repayment grants from the
16		skilled workforce student loan repayment program fund directly to the Bank of North
17		Dakota or other participating lender to repay outstanding student loan principal
18		balances for eligible applicants. The maximum annual student loan repayment grant
19		amount for which an applicant may qualify is five thousand six hundred sixty-seven
20		dollars, or one-third of the applicant's outstanding student loan principal balance,
21		whichever is less. The maximum total student loan repayment grant amount for which
22		any applicant may qualify is seventeen thousand dollars.
23	<u>7.</u>	If an individual is receiving loan forgiveness under any other provision, the individual
24		may not receive a student loan repayment grant under this section during the same
25		application year.
26	<u>8.</u>	The skilled workforce student loan repayment program must be a joint public and
27		private effort. The Bank of North Dakota shall provide one dollar of funding for each
28		one dollar of funding raised from the private sector.
29	<u>9.</u>	The North Dakota university system in cooperation with the North Dakota workforce
30		development council shall seek private matching funds for the skilled workforce

1		student loan repayment program. Any matching funds received must be deposited in
2		the skilled workforce student loan repayment program fund.
3	—SEC	CTION 2. A new section to chapter 6-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
4	and ena	ected as follows:
5	— <u>Ski</u>	lled workforce student loan repayment program fund established - Continuing
6	approp	riation.
7	—— <u>The</u>	skilled workforce student loan repayment program fund is established as a revolving
8	fund. All	moneys deposited or transferred into the fund and interest earned on moneys in the
9	fund are	e appropriated for the purposes of section 1 of this Act.
10	—SEC	CTION 3. TRANSFER - BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA - SKILLED WORKFORCE
11	STUDE	NT LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM FUND. The Bank of North Dakota shall transfer
12	the sum	of \$5,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the Bank's current
13	earning	s and undivided profits to the skilled workforce student loan repayment program fund
14	during t	he period beginning with the effective date of this Act, and ending June 30, 2021.
15	—SEC	CTION 4. EXPIRATION DATE. Section 2 of this Act is effective through June 30, 2021,
16	and afte	er that date is ineffective.
17	SE	CTION 5. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
18	SEC	CTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
19	and ena	acted as follows:
20	Ski	lled workforce student loan repayment program - Skilled workforce student loan
21	<u>repaym</u>	ent program fund - Continuing appropriation - Report.
22	1	There is created in the state treasury the skilled workforce student loan repayment
23		program fund. The fund consists of moneys transferred into the fund by the legislative
24		assembly, matching funds received, and loan repayments. Moneys in the fund are
25		appropriated to the state board of higher education on a continuing basis for the
26		purpose of distributing student loan repayment grants directly to the Bank of North
27		Dakota or other participating lender to repay outstanding student loan principal
28		balances for eligible applicants.
29	2.	The state board of higher education shall adopt policies and procedures to develop,
30		implement, promote, and administer a skilled workforce student loan repayment
31		program in cooperation with the Bank of North Dakota and the North Dakota workforce

- development council with the intent of attracting and retaining individuals for professional or technical skills in high demand in this state.
- 3. The North Dakota workforce development council in cooperation with job service North Dakota shall use available labor market information to determine annually the eligible high-demand professional and technical skills and emerging occupations in this state.
- 4. The state board of higher education and the North Dakota workforce development council shall compile a list of qualifying educational programs annually. Qualifying education programs must pertain to the professional and technical skills and emerging occupations in high demand in this state, as determined under subsection 3.
 Qualifying educational programs may include degree or certificate programs.
- 5. Graduates of qualifying educational programs from institutions or entities in this state may apply for the skilled workforce student loan repayment program. To be eligible to receive student loan repayment grants under the program, the applicant:
 - a. Must have successfully completed a qualifying educational program from an eligible institution of higher education;
 - b. Must have a student loan with the Bank of North Dakota or other participating lender:
 - c. Following completion of a qualifying educational program, must reside and work
 in this state in an eligible high-demand or emerging occupation; and
 - d. Must have met and shall continue to meet any requirements established by rule.
- 6. The state board of higher education shall adopt rules to ensure compliance with residency and occupation requirements after completion of the qualifying educational program.
- 7. The state board of higher education shall distribute student loan repayment grants

 from the skilled workforce student loan repayment program fund directly to the Bank of

 North Dakota or other participating lender to repay outstanding student loan principal

 balances for eligible applicants. The maximum annual student loan repayment grant

 amount for which an applicant may qualify is five thousand six hundred sixty-seven

 dollars, or one-third of the applicant's outstanding student loan principal balance upon

 initial application for the program, whichever is less. The maximum total student loan

- of higher education, North Dakota nonpublic accredited institutions of higher education, and tribally controlled community colleges.
- 2. The state board of higher education shall adopt policies and procedures to develop, implement, promote, and administer a skilled workforce scholarship program in cooperation with the Bank of North Dakota and the North Dakota workforce development council with the intent of attracting and retaining individuals for professional or technical skills in high demand in this state.
- 3. The North Dakota workforce development council in cooperation with job service North

 Dakota shall use available labor market information to determine annually the eligible

 high-demand professional and technical skills and emerging occupations in this state.
- 4. The state board of higher education and the workforce development council shall compile a list of qualifying educational programs annually. Qualifying educational programs must be able to be completed within four semesters or six quarters and must pertain to the professional and technical skills and emerging occupations in high demand in this state, as determined under subsection 3. Qualifying educational programs may include degree or certificate programs.
- 5. Individuals enrolled in a qualifying educational program in this state may apply for a scholarship under this section. Scholarships are limited to the amount charged each quarter, semester, or term by the educational institution for the tuition, fees, books, and supplies required for the qualifying educational program. The scholarships are intended to supplement any other scholarship or financial aid grant received by a student to assist the student with the costs of the qualifying educational program. An individual may not receive more than seventeen thousand dollars in total under this section.
- 6. To be eligible for a scholarship under this section, a student must be enrolled full time in an eligible program and maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average, based on a 4.0 grading system, or maintain academic progress in the program according to program requirements. A student may not receive scholarships under this section for more than the equivalent of four semesters of full-time enrollment or six quarters of full-time enrollment.

SECTION 4. TRANSFER - BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA - SKILLED WORKFORCE
SCHOLARSHIP FUND. The Bank of North Dakota shall transfer the sum of \$3,000,000, or so
much of the sum as may be necessary, from the Bank's current earnings and undivided profits
to the skilled workforce scholarship fund during the period beginning with the effective date of
this Act, and ending June 30, 2021.
SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
