3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM.

- During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the
 feasibility and desirability of developing a school choice program to provide parents of
 students with options, funding, and support in selecting charter schools, magnet
 schools, or private schools for their children. The study must include:
- 9 a. The design, application, operations, and costs associated with the
 10 implementation of the program;
- b. Consideration of educational savings accounts, and may include other types of
 school choice programs; and
- c. A review of the best practices across the nation for similar programs and the
 associated requirements for guidance and monitoring of the program by the
 department of public instruction.
- The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together
 with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh
 legislative assembly.
