- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 40-18 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the location of a proceeding before a municipal judge and the use of
- 3 reliable electronic means.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 40-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Change of venue Reliable electronic means.
- 8 <u>1. A municipal judge may change the venue of a proceeding under this chapter upon</u> 9 <u>consideration of the following factors:</u>
- 10 <u>a. Convenience to the parties and witnesses;</u>
- b. Judicial efficiency;
- 12 <u>c. Available facilities; and</u>
- d. <u>Administration of justice.</u>
- 14 <u>2. A municipal judge may not change the venue of a proceeding if any party to the proceeding objects to the change.</u>
- 16 <u>3. A municipal judge may use contemporaneous audio or audiovisual transmission by</u>
- 17 <u>reliable electronic means in accordance with rule 52 of the North Dakota Supreme</u>
- 18 <u>Court Administrative Rules. A municipal judge who presides over a proceeding through</u>
- contemporaneous audio or audiovisual transmission by reliable electronic means is
- 20 <u>equivalent to a municipal judge who is physically present at the proceeding.</u>
