- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-33 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to limitations on public employer consideration of criminal background.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-33 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 **Public employment - Consideration of criminal record.**

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>A public employer may not inquire into or consider the criminal record or criminal</u>
- 8 <u>history of an applicant for public employment until the applicant has been selected for</u>
 9 an interview by the employer.
- 10 <u>2.</u> This section does not apply to the department of corrections and rehabilitation or to a
- 11 public employer that has a statutory duty to conduct a criminal history background
- 12 <u>check or otherwise take into consideration a potential employee's criminal history</u>
- 13 <u>during the hiring process.</u>
- 14 <u>3.</u> <u>This section does not prohibit a public employer from notifying an applicant that law or</u>
- the employer's policy will disqualify an individual with a particular criminal history
 background from employment in particular positions.
- 17 <u>4.</u> As used in this section, the term "public employer" means the state or a county or city
- 18 government, or an instrumentality or agency of the state or of a county or city
- 19 government. The term includes a park district but does not include a school district.
